Biosketch

Professor Francesco Béguinot, MD, PhD, is a certified clinical specialist in Internal Medicine. He spent about two years as a research scientist at the NIDDK, NIH, Bethesda, and three years at the Joslin Diabetes Center, Harvard Medical School, in Boston. He has later been appointed Professor of Laboratory Medicine at the Federico II University of Naples where he directs a research group working in the field of diabetes. He has been Dean ad interim at the Federico II University Medical School, in Naples, and is presently Dean of Research and Head, Department of Laboratory Medicine at this same University. He is also Director of the CNR "Genomics of Diabetes" Unit, and Coordinator, PhD programme in Experimental and Clinical Medicine at the University of Naples.

Professor Béguinot has a long lasting scientific interest in the field of Type 2 diabetes clinical and experimental. Over the past 10 years, he focused on diabetes epigenetics and cell senescence in metabolic disorders. He coordinated several national and international research initiatives in the field, funded by the European Union, the Italian Ministry of Education, the CNR and INSERM.
